SUMMARY:

(i) Solar Wings has been in-contact with the Rotax dealer over this matter, but has to report that nothing conclusive was attained during discussions. However, trials are taking place using 'O' rings to tie down the plug leads. It is hoped that using a non-absorbent material will preclude the chance of spark loss due to tracking in wet weather, a problem known to have occurred with shock cord retained systems.
