## P&M Aviation Technora Strip Guarantee First time owners & Technora Replacement Strips

P&M Aviation Ltd. will guarantee that Modification 236 Technora Strips applied to the Quik, Quik GT450, QuikR and Quik GTR wings will last the life of the wing sail whilst it is owned by the original owner of the aircraft. Should the strip fail the Brookstest then the Technora strips will be replaced free of charge at P&M Aviation Ltd. premises.

The owner is responsible for returning and collecting the wing/sail to the factory for the strips to be replaced.

If a complete wing is returned, P&M Aviation Ltd. will remove the sail and replace the Technora strips and re-fit, but will not conduct a full wing strip and rebuild of the frame, unless requested by the owner, and at the owners expense. The price for this will be advised at the time. P&M Aviation Ltd. are not responsible for any additional costs associated with removing and refitting the sail by the owner or his agents.

All sails that are returned for replacement under the guarantee will be tested to confirm that the Technora has indeed failed the Brookstest, and the owner advised of any anomalies.

The overall condition of the wing sail will also be checked, including the standard Betts test to confirm that the sail life has not been reached.

For first time owners the registration certificate will need to be checked, for Technora Replacement Strips a valid receipt and log book entry showing the date of replacement is required.

P&M Aviation reserve the right to replace the strips with an alternative material as appropriate at the time of replacement.

Accidental damage is specifically excluded from the guarantee.

The lifetime guarantee is dependent upon confirmation that the aircraft has been serviced and maintained in accordance with the Aircraft Operators Manual.

## P&M Aviation Technora Strip Guarantee – 2<sup>nd</sup> Hand Owners

P&M Aviation Ltd. will guarantee that Modification 236 Technora Strips applied to the Quik, Quik GT450, QuikR and Quik GTR wings will last 5 years from the time that the strips were fitted to the sail for all second hand owners of aircraft. Should the strips fail the Brookstest then the Technora strips will be replaced free of charge at P&M Aviation Ltd. premises

A copy of the log book entry for the application of the strips is required for date of manufacture/fitting.

The owner is responsible for returning and collecting the wing/sail to the factory for the strip to be replaced.

If a complete wing is returned, P&M Aviation will remove the sail and replace the bands and re-fit, but will not conduct a full strip and rebuild of the frame, unless requested by the owner, and at the owners expense. The price for this will be advised at the time. P&M Aviation Ltd. are not responsible for any additional costs associated with removing and refitting the sail by the owner or his agents.

All sails that are returned for replacement under the guarantee will be tested to confirm that the Technora has indeed failed the Brookstest, and the owner advised of any anomalies.

The overall condition of the wing sail will also be checked, including the standard Betts test to confirm that the sail life has not been reached.

P&M Aviation reserve the right to replace the strips with an alternative material as appropriate at the time of replacement.

Accidental damage is specifically excluded from the guarantee.

The 5 year guarantee is dependent upon confirmation that the aircraft has been serviced and maintained in accordance with the Aircraft Operators Manual.
